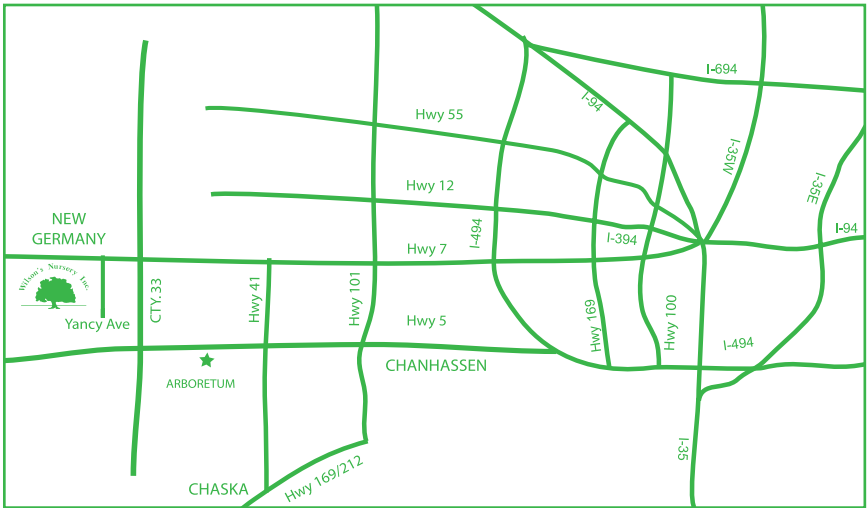

## **About our Super 2**

In the interest of serving our customers and reducing confusion, we have changed some of our pot sizes. You will notice many of our shrubs are listed as a Super 2. This is the same pot we have previously sold as a #3 container, but due to the fact that it actually is less than a 3 gallon capacity – but is more than what many are calling a #2 – we are referring to it as a Super 2. It holds approximately 2.4 gallons. We find that this pot gives a superior root system and holds moisture better while waiting on the job to be installed. We feel this provides a superior product for our customers.

You will also notice that “Proven Winners” and “First Editions” plants are in their own branded pots. They are designated as PW or FE.
